
Perceptions of Policing: A Comparison of Extreme-Right and Extreme-Left Discussion Forums

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Background

- This presentation summarizes progress to date on an exploratory analysis of a database containing 14 million posts from social media and discussion forums known to host misinformation, extremism, and conspiracism (“MEC sector”).
- Database includes material from both Extreme Right and Extreme Left
- Historically both groups are regarded as critical of law enforcement (Danahy, 2022) and are often described as intensely opposed factors, which results in acrimonious online debates and various protests and counter protests (Klein, 2019; Wood, 2020).
- Research Question: Have current events like BLM protests and FBI raid on Mar-a-Lago changed the dynamics between groups?



What is Extremism?

Extremism = groups outside the normal political spectrum

Forum types identified by forum name, description, and reputation.

Extreme Left

- Anarchists
- Antifascists
- Anti-rightists
- Socialists

Extreme Right

- National Socialists
- Proud Boys
- White Pride / KKK
- Sovereign Citizens
- Anarchocapitalists

Later additions:

- Conspiracy/fringe
- QAnon
- Patriot / Veterans
- Political Right
- News / Politics
- Religion
- Heath Misinformation



Methods I: FOMECC

- Data Source
 - Frames of Misinformation, Extremism, & Conspiracism (FOMECC) project at Youngstown State University. YSU IRB #2022-191.
 - Purposive sample of forums found on 13 different platforms known to host MEC sector discussions for a period from April 2018 to November 2022.
 - 14 million posts with 50+ words
- Web scraping/ exporting tools
 - Screaming Frog
 - Python,
 - Telegram Export
- 3 small studies
 - Forum analysis: Stata 17.0 MP
 - Kmeans cluster analysis: Stata 17.0 SE, Stata ngram module
 - Sentiment analysis: Linguistic Inquiry and Word Count software (Tausczik & Pennebaker, 2010)



Methods II: Police Frames

- This study uses 891,795 posts regarding policing (6.3% of posts).
- Text mining of key words and phrases. Examples:
 - *General References*: policing, cop, detective, deputy, federal bureau of investigation, fbi, law enforcement, security guard, sheriff, patrol, us marshal, arrest, forensic school resource officer, stop and frisk, terry stop strip search. qualified immunity
 - *Use of Force*: use of force, deadly force, excessive force, swat, taser, George Floyd, Freddie Gray Breonna Taylor, Chauvin
 - *Police brutality*: handcuffs, kill, punch, shooting, shot, suspended

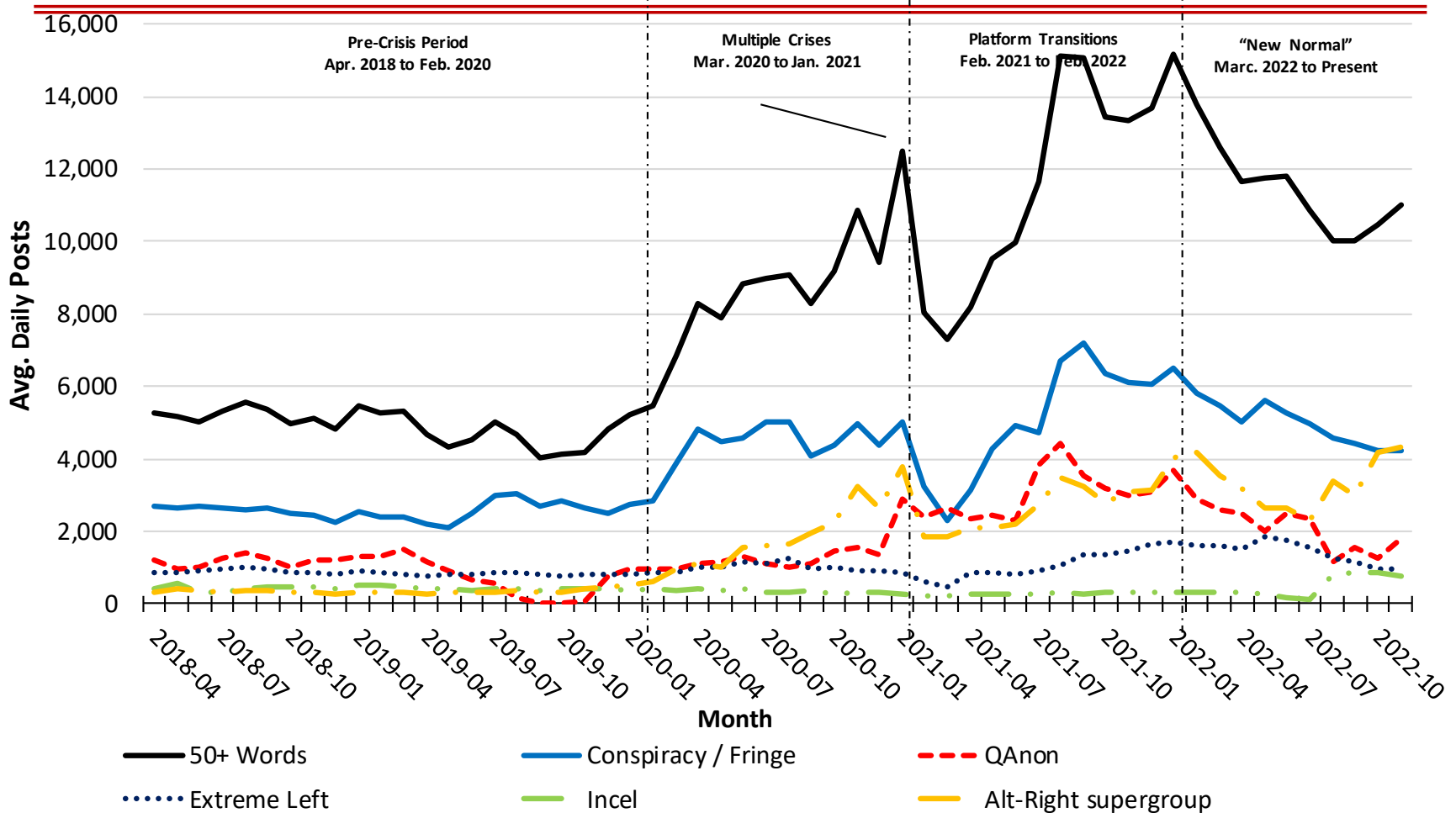

Avg. Daily Activity by Month

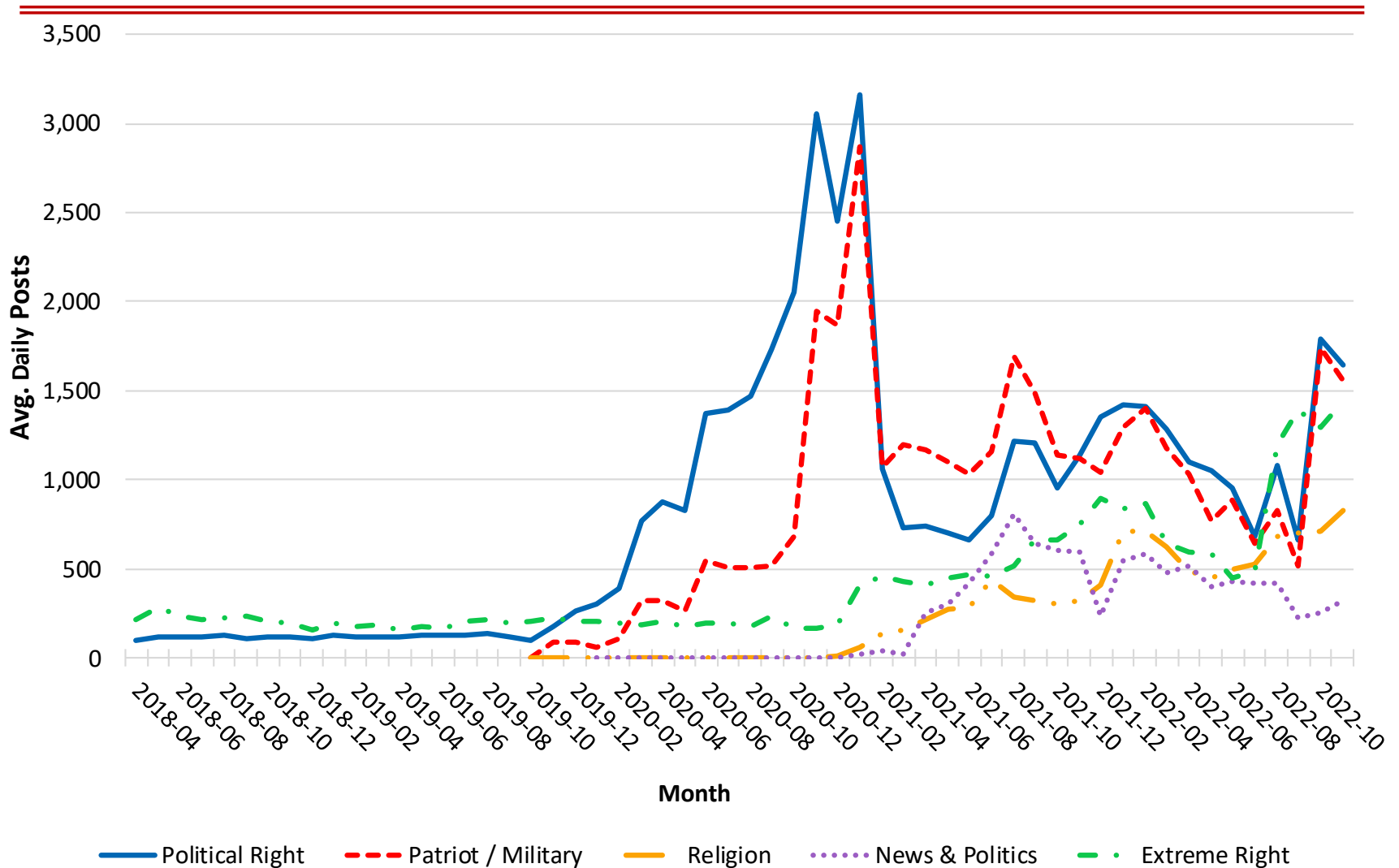


Note: 14,260,073 recovered posts with at least 50 words. Forums are not mutually exclusive. QAnon forums could be classified as both Conspiracy/Fringe and Extreme Right, but QAnon forums are separated due to their size and influence. This report uses a broad definition of the Alt-Right supergroup, which include both Extreme-Right groups (e.g., neo-Nazis, Boys, secessionists) and right-leaning groups with which Extreme-Right groups appear to be forming ideological alliances (Rogers, 2021). The breakout of the Alt-Right can be found in Figure 3. Health Misinformation forums not shown due to their small numbers most months.

Periods: The period of multiple crises refers to the influence of the COVID-19 pandemic, BLM protests, and 2020 presidential election activity. Platform Transition highlights the rise of new extremist and conspiracists forums in the universe of platforms, many due to their expulsion from Facebook and Twitter and the collapse of Parler.



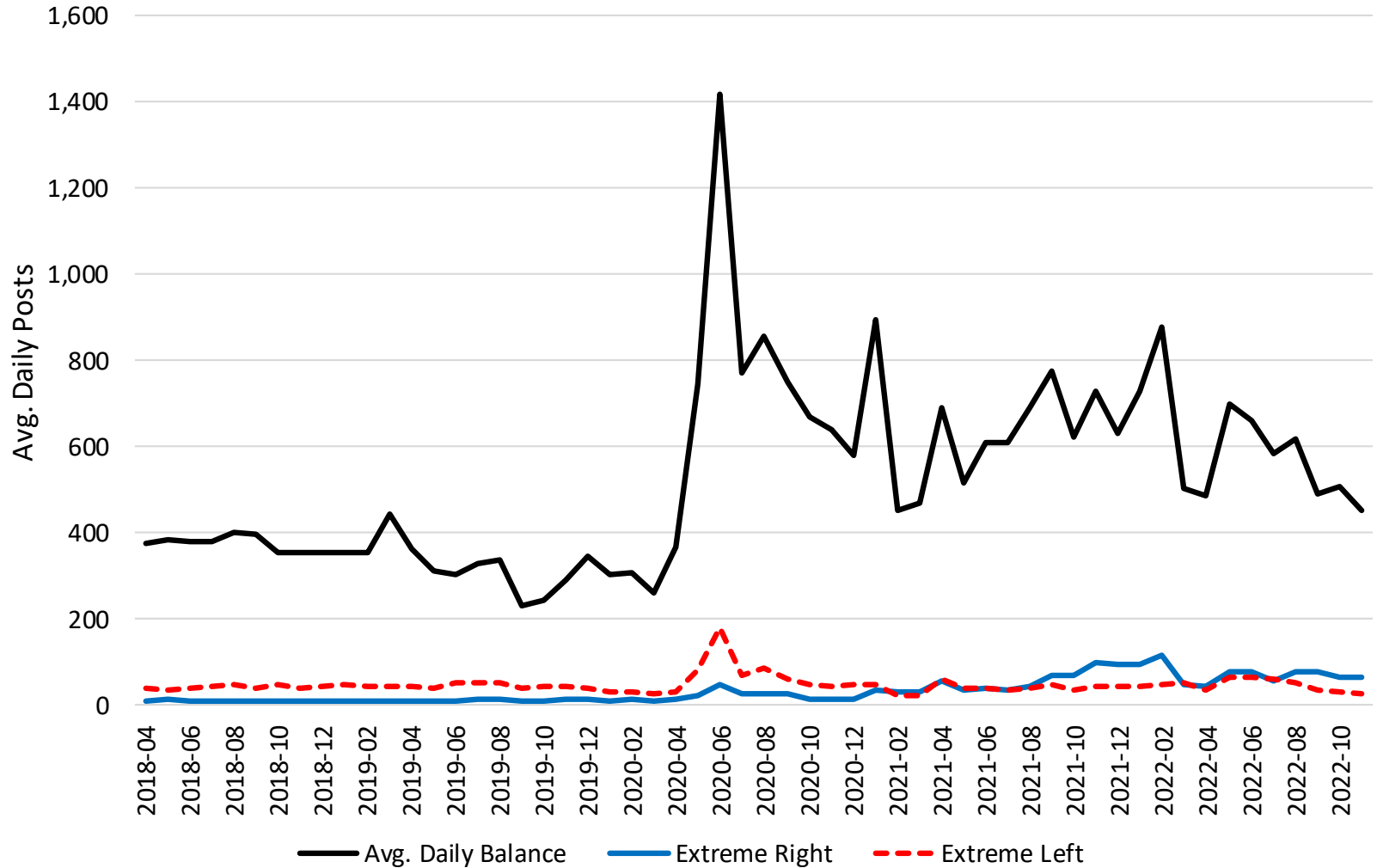
Avg. Daily Activity by Month for Alt-Right Supergroup by Month



Note: 2,917,274 recovered posts. These groups are a subset of forums classified as Alt-Right in Figure 1. The category Extreme Right includes but is not limited to neo-Nazis, Proud Boys, secessionists, and sovereign citizens. The Political Right includes partisan groups related to MAGA and libertarianism. While this study does not examine mainstream political sites, the discourse of partisan forums selected for the purposive sample often strays beyond normal partisan discourse.



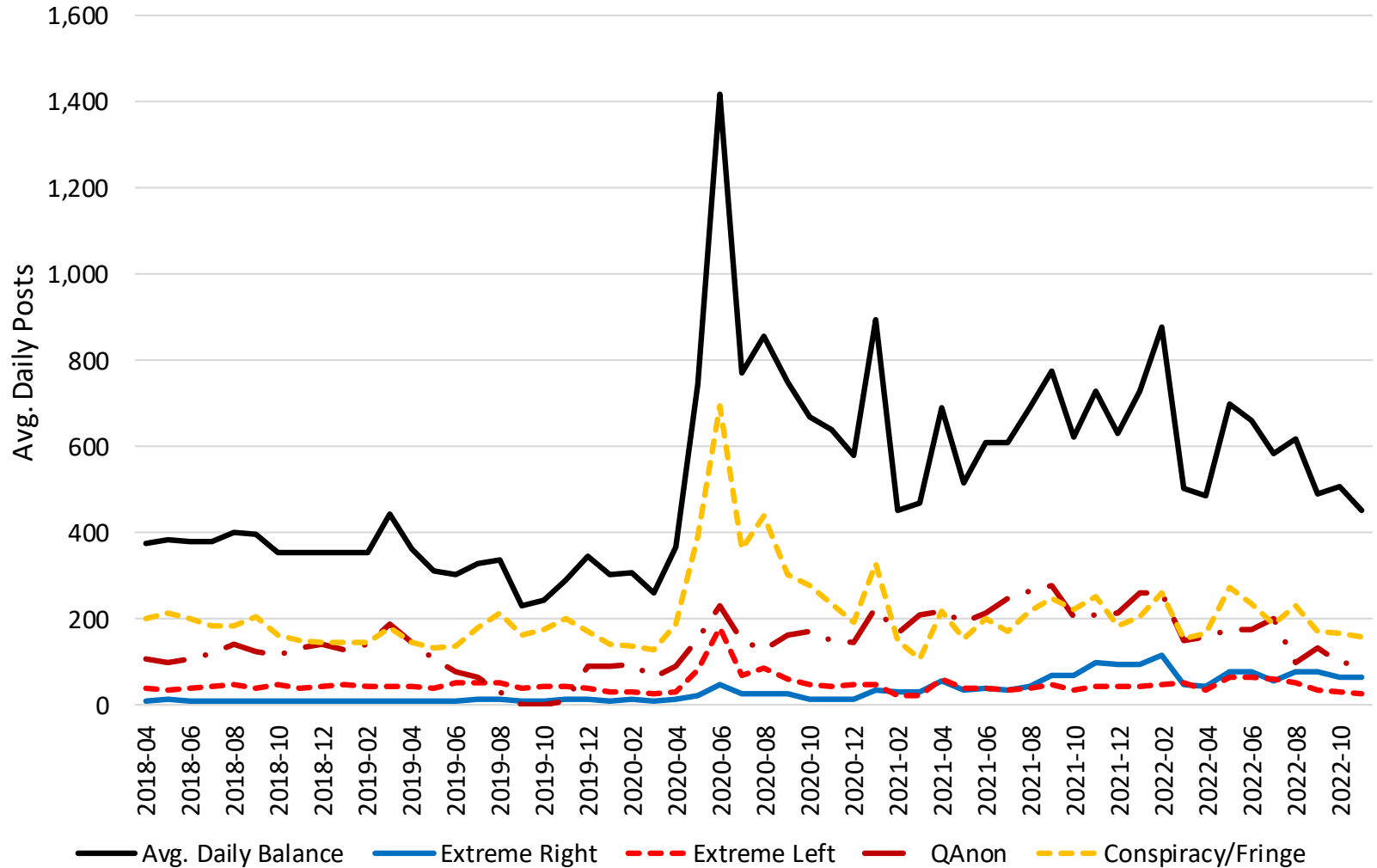
Average Daily Posts for Police Perception Study



Notes: N=891,795 posts.



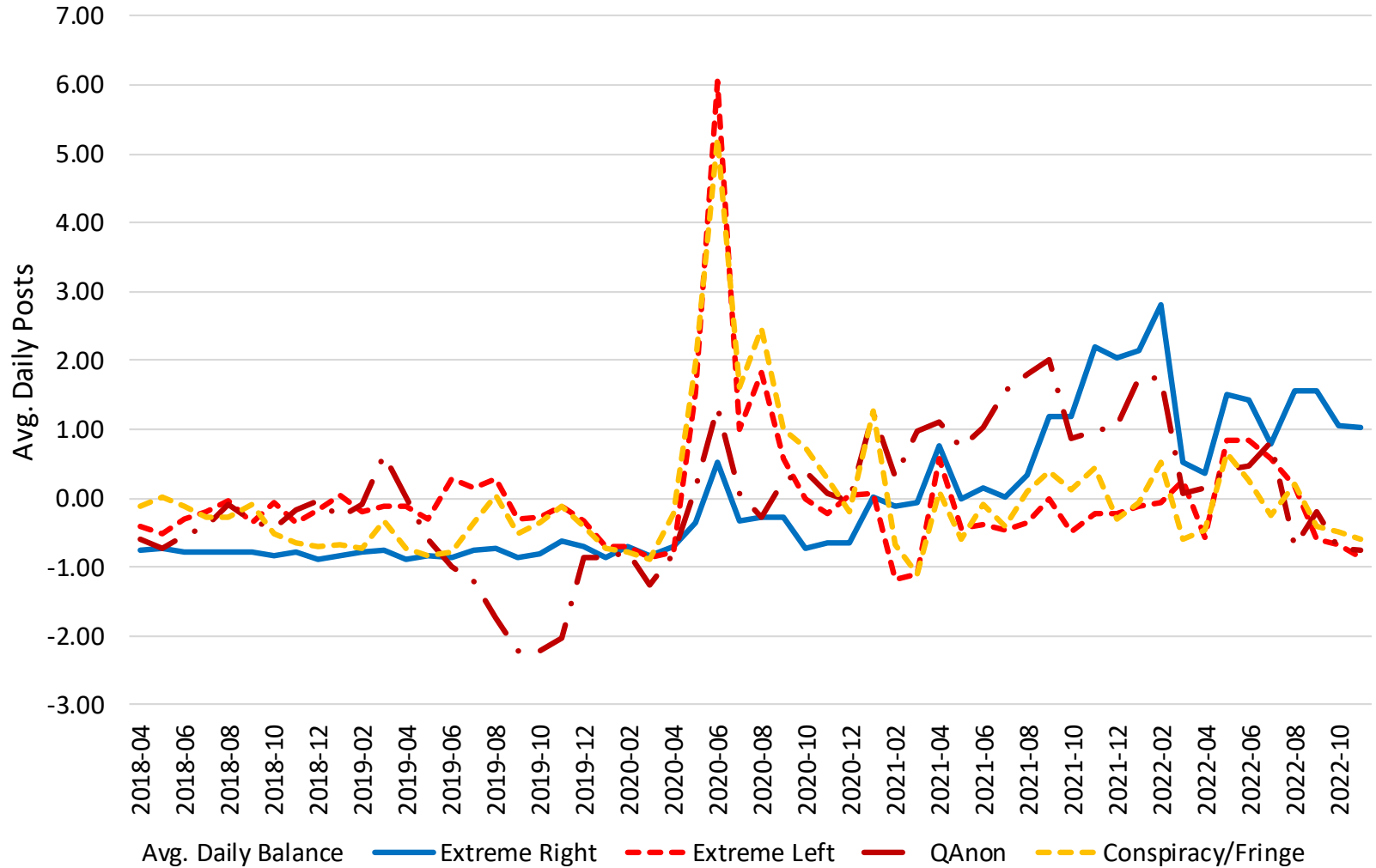
Average Daily Posts for Police Perception Study
